SUCCESSFUL STUDENTS

This fund is all about the students and faculty! It helps in three major ways.

✓ **Mini Grants**

CWI seeks to provide an array of opportunities to help students receive the well-rounded educational experience needed to succeed in the 21st century workforce. These internal competitive mini-grants can fund professional development, training workshops, and ideas that advance education and students.

✓ **Cap and Gown Fund**

After CWI's first graduation, the Foundation had many requests for cap and gown expenses. Students who may not be able to afford a cap and gown often choose not to participate in the ceremony because of their lack of academic attire.

LEGACY FUND (ENDOWED)

When you make a gift to the College's endowment fund, you are truly leaving a legacy. Endowed investments provide perpetual funding that keeps the promise of accessible education alive – now and forever. The money you give to the Legacy Fund never gets spent-- only the interest from your gift is awarded each year. All contributions to the fund increase the principal balance. Gifts of all sizes can be combined to make a meaningful endowment.

GENERAL EDUCATION (GEN ED) GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP

This general scholarship fund will be used to fund scholarships for students enrolled in our general education programs.

PROFESSIONAL TECHNICAL EDUCATION (PTE) GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP

The PTE programs are industry and market driven by preparing students for high demand jobs in the region and are critical to the big picture of life-long learning, ongoing training and education, economic vitality, and success in the workplace.
