PROGRESS TOWARD A DEGREE or CERTIFICATE

1. Each financial aid recipient must be admitted to the College as a degree or certificate seeking student in an eligible program.
2. At this time, you have reached the point of appeal*** as indicated in the chart below and are now required to submit this maximum credit appeal in order to continue your eligibility for financial aid.
3. Financial aid eligibility is limited by federal regulations to 150% of the total number of credits required to complete your chosen degree or certificate. The 150% credit evaluation is calculated as follows:

4. If, at any time, it is determined that you have reached, exceeded, or cannot complete your degree requirements within the 150% federal limit, you will be ineligible for further aid. No exceptions or appeals of the 150% credit hour maximum can be considered.

The following chart indicates the required credits needed to complete a degree/certificate, the point where an appeal for further aid must be made, and the maximum number of credits within which you must be able to complete your degree/certificate.

***Point of Appeal credits vary according to each individual program.
