Footnotes:

1 Communication majors should take the Math Diagnostic for math placement upon acceptance to CWI. The Math Diagnostic will inform the student if a review course such as MATH 095 is needed prior to entering MATH 123 (Math in Modern Society) or MATH 143 (College Algebra). MATH 143 has a prerequisite of MATH 095 or equivalent placement score. If a student changes majors at the AA or BA level, or is considering graduate school, the Department of Philosophy and Communication recommends enrolling in MATH 143.

2 Students who are interested in COMM 114 are encouraged to enroll during their first semester at CWI to utilize the full four semesters during which the course can be taken.
