Additional Advising Comments for Psychology Majors

*** See current catalog for a list of courses that will fulfill CWI’s general education requirements.**

Psychology majors are encouraged to start taking math and science classes immediately rather than waiting. Take the Math Diagnostic for math placement upon acceptance to CWI. The Math Diagnostic will inform the student if a review course such as MATH 095 is needed prior to entering MATH 143 - College Algebra or MATH 153 - Elementary Statistics.

PSYC 190 (Writing for the Social Sciences), PSYC 250 (Introduction to Research Methods in the Social Sciences), and PSYC 290 (Psychology Capstone) will transfer to most four-year institutions as elective courses. Nonetheless, these courses will help you be prepared for coursework as a Psychology major at the junior and senior level.

Footnotes:

1 MATH 095 (or similar placement score) is a prerequisite for MATH 143 (College Algebra), MATH 153 (Elementary Statistics), and PSYC 251 (Statistical Methods). Select MATH 143 or MATH 153 based upon the Math requirements of the transfer institution you plan to attend. MATH 153 is the recommended math course (unless different than preferred transfer institution requires).

3 Review the CWI 2017-18 Catalog and transfer institution requirements to help select the most beneficial elective course(s).
