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**Additional Advising Comments for Sociology Majors**

Sociology majors are encouraged to start taking math and science classes immediately rather than waiting. Take the Math Diagnostic for math placement upon acceptance to CWI. The Math Diagnostic will inform the student if a review course such as MATH 095 is needed prior to entering MATH 130 (Finite Math), MATH 143 (College Algebra), or MATH 153 (Elementary Statistics).

**Footnotes:**

**1** MATH 095 (or similar placement score) is a prerequisite for MATH 130 (Finite Math), MATH 143 (College Algebra), and MATH 153 (Elementary Statistics), and PSYC 251. Select MATH 130, MATH 143, or MATH 153 based upon the Math requirements of the transfer institution you plan to attend.
