Immunizations and Physicals

Immunizations

All students enrolled in the CWI Surgical Technology Program are required to have the following immunizations.

Please do not bring in your **original** immunization records, and **do not send** them in over the summer. Make **copies** of all of your records and bring one copy on the **the first day of Fall Semester.**

We will NOT make copies for you on the first day of class so please come in prepared with these items. You will need copies of these records also to submit to the various hospitals so make several copies so they are ready to go when the hospitals ask for them.

These are the requirements:

Negative TB test
MMR or positive titer
DPT or Tdap

A positive titer for Varicella, **or** the vaccine. (Chicken Pox)

Hepatitis B vaccine, you will have 3 injections. You **must** have completed the first injection prior to the first day of class Fall Semester.

Your family physician (they will be able to bill insurance if you have it.)
