RFP 03-2022 BOISE CENTER P3 DEVELOPMENT – CONSIDER EVALUATION COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

Nic Miller, Assistant Vice President, Office of Strategic Initiatives

Assistant Vice President Miller thanked the Evaluation Committee, CWI Legal and Procurement Team and all the development teams who brought forth their proposals. There has been a lot of hard work to get to this point.

The recommendation of the Evaluation Committee will be taken into consideration and the Board of Trustees will be asked for their approval. Upon approval, we will then move into

negotiations around the development agreement, and come back to the Trustees later, for approval of the agreement.

Vice President Miller reviewed the selection criteria and team scoring.

Team Scoring: (Total 1,470 points)

- Lincoln Property Company 1,140 points
- Hawkins Companies 1,164 points
- Ball Ventures Ahlquist (BVA) 1,298 points

Ball Ventures Ahlquist is the team put forth as the recommendation from the Selection Committee.

- Trustee Bradshaw asked if there were any comments from the Trustees who
 participated on the Selection Committee. Vice Chair Buckner-Webb commented,
 Vice President Nic Miller encapsulated the decision very well, and in the end, the
 group was very confident of their decision and this is the development company CWI
 should be working with.
- Chair Lenty asked Vice President Miller to share additional comments shared collectively by the committee. Vice President Miller stated a very strong team was assembled by BVA and included Engineered Structures, Inc. (ESI) and Hummel Architects.
- Trustee Hightower commented that early on in this process, the Trustees were asked what they would like to see. Trustee Hightower is very appreciative her comments were reflected in the scoring metrics.
- Trustee Reames commented on his appreciation for all of the design build teams
 who took the time to submit their proposals. This is a testament to their passion for
 our community and CWI, and they support and believe in what we are trying to
 accomplish.
