• Remove the *Notice of Concern* on Standards 2.B.1, 2.B.4, 2.D.10, 2.G.3, 4.A.2, 4.A.6, 5.B.1, and 5.B.2

## **Required Follow-Up**

The Commission has rescinded the request for a Spring 2018 Ad Hoc Report with a visit and requests that the College of Western Idaho:

1. Submit an Addendum to the Fall 2019 Mid-Cycle Self-Evaluation Report to again address Recommendations 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the Fall 2016 Initial Accreditation Peer Evaluation Report

- Mid-Cycle Evaluation in Fall 2019
- Submit an Addendum to the Fall 2019 Mid-Cycle Evaluation Report to address Recommendations 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the Fall 2016 Initial Accreditation Peer Evaluation Report
- Year Seven Evaluation in Fall 2023
